Universities naturally want to ensure that you can cope with your studies and that language will not be a barrier to your performance.

Most universities will accept Grade B or C in O level or GCSE.

Certain courses will require higher level of English - these could include programmes which require clinical or education placements where you will need to interact with the local public, or for programmes such as Law, Literature, Philosophy.

The English language requirement is determined by individual university and course. Discuss your options with your Education Planner at HRDS who will advise you of the best course of action. Remember, you do not need an external English language result when you apply to a university - you will receive an offer which will state if additional English test is required.
