

## Flexibility of entry requirements



UK universities look at a combination of factors to assess your eligibility - academic merit, the personal statement, reference(s), work experience, portfolio, interview etc. They can thus be flexible with the grade requirement of your previous studies if your personal statement and reference are strong and you have the required subjects.

Australian universities usually do not require a reference or personal statement. There is thus little flexibility in accepting students who fall below the published required grades.

Some universities in the UK and Australia run the International Year One programme - this enables students who have just missed out on their grades to develop the necessary skills to join the second year of a related degree. Under smaller classroom setting, teachers work closely with students to bring you a personalised studying experience that will maximise your chances of having a successful university degree.
