

# Interviews



Most applications for healthcare programmes as well as some art and design as well as education related programmes include interviews as part of the assessment process.

Students are usually called for an interview if they have already been assessed for meeting academic criteria, have received a satisfactory reference (UK universities), the personal statement was well written (UK universities) and the students has scored well in an aptitude test if it was required.

Interviews are either held in the region - Malaysia, Singapore or Hong Kong, by video conference or in the UK. Universities use various formats for the interview; research well before attending the interview.

Interviews for medical and allied health also include an additional dimension - the interviewers will try to assess your suitability for the psychological demands of the profession, your communication skills, your ethical values, your empathy, team work, social skills etc.
