

Timing of the application



The sooner you start preparing your university application, the higher the chances are of finding an institution/course that suits you best. Applying to a university is a major step - you will be spending 3-5 years on your studies and the right course and university environment will ensure you will enjoy your time there.

Preparing early will allow you to do ample research on the programme and also to sort out your documents, prepare the personal statement etc.

The personal statement that you will need for your application to a UK university requires serious effort. You will go through numerous drafts and you should not rush through this important step.

Certain courses in the UK and Australia have strict quotas on the number of international students they can accept. Acceptance is on a rota basis - an early application will ensure consideration for suitability.

Please follow any application deadlines that the university might have in place. Late applications are usually not considered and the university will ask you to defer to the following year
